

Utah State University College of Veterinary Medicine (CVM) Update

August 2026

In July, the CVM moved into its newly named Thomas and Patricia Willis Veterinary Medical Education building that allows us to accommodate a larger incoming class of 79 students this fall. Photos of the new building are provided below. For the admission cycle for students entering this fall, applications were received from 39 Nevada residents and 75% met GPA cutoffs. Offers of acceptance were initially made to 17 Nevada residents, and 15 accepted and 2 declined. Three additional Nevada residents on the waitlist received offers of acceptance, and two accepted. Of the 17 Nevada residents admitted, 15 were accepted into the Nevada Health Professional Education Program (HPEP). Orientation for the incoming cohort of students (i.e., Class of 2030) starts on Monday, August 17th, culminating with the White Coat Ceremony on Friday, August 21st. Dr. Boyd Spratling will represent the Nevada VMA at the White Coat Ceremony where he will present each Nevada student with their coat and he will provide remarks at the ceremony.

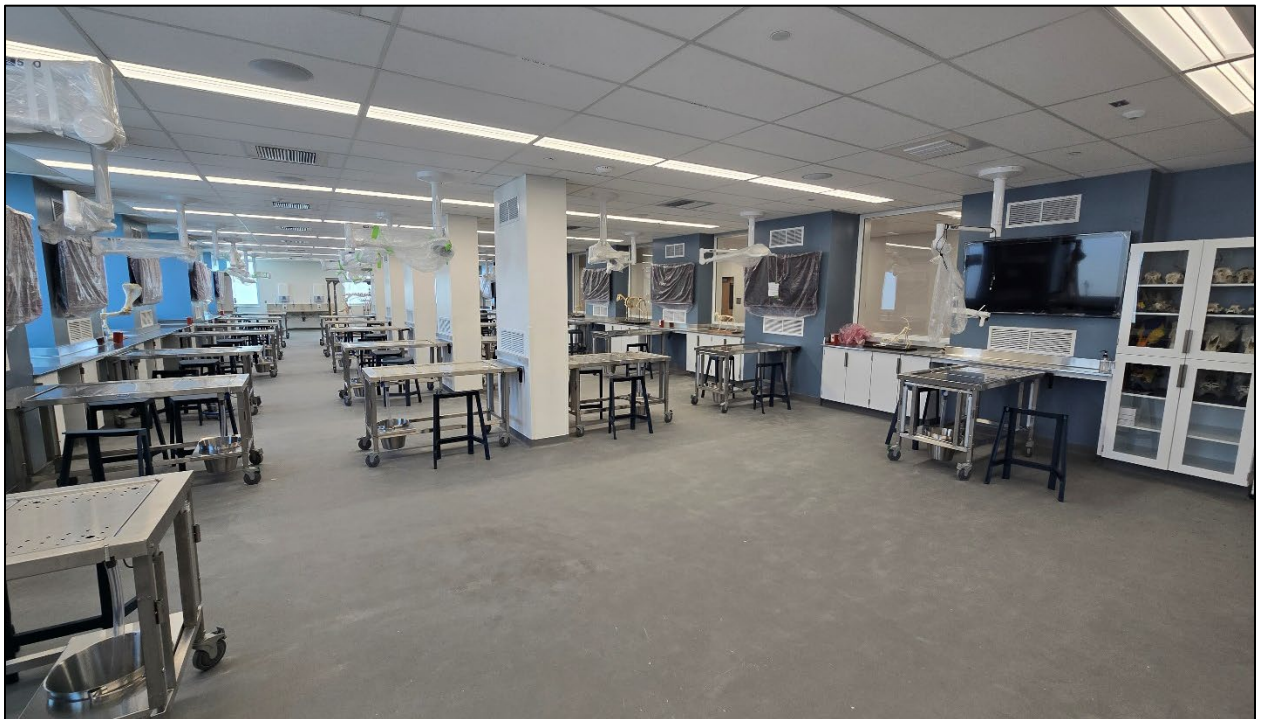
